#### **Perforator Catheter**

\*As of September 2024

\*\*The Venclose Maven™ Perforator Catheter uses 0.5 cm segmental ablation with a 20-second ablation cycle. The ClosureRFS™ Stylet uses pull back or focal ablation. Both ClosureRFS™ Stylet ablation methods require an initial quadrant ablation treatment time of 4 minutes. The pull back method requires additional quadrant ablation treatments for 1 minute per 1 cm, and the focal method requires additional quadrant ablation of subsequently treated adjacent vein segments for 4 minutes each. The ClosureRFS™ Stylet information was obtained from the manufacturer's procedure quidelines.
